

#### **Abbreviations**

Note: There are two kinds of terminology used for crochet patterns, British and US. The US terms are given in brackets where they differ from British terms.

ch	chain	X	times. For example " x 2 " means to do a

This pattern is for changing colours after every round.

### Make a magic ring.

- **Round 1** Ch1, 1dc into ring, ch1, 1tr into ring. (Ch3, 3tr into ring) x 3, ch3, 1tr into ring. Tighten ring and finish tail.
- **Round 2** St-tr in *any* corner sp, 1tr in same corner sp. \*Ch1, (3tr, 3ch, 3tr) in next corner sp. Rep from \* x 2. Ch1, 3tr in next corner sp, 3ch, 1tr in same corner sp, finish tail.
- **Round 3** St-tr in *any* 1-ch sp on a side, 1tr in same sp. \*Ch1, (3tr, 3ch, 3tr) in next corner sp, ch1, 3tr in next 1-ch sp. Rep from \* x 2, (3tr, 3ch, 3tr) in next corner sp, ch1, 1tr in next ch-1 sp, finish tail.

## Chain Step 1



With one loop already on the hook, bring the yarn over the hook,

## Step 2



draw the yarn through the loop already on the hook,

## Step 3



1 chain completed.

## Left-handed

#### **Double crochet**

Step 1



With one loop already on the hook,

Step 2



insert the hook as directed into the work,

Step 3



bring the yarn over the hook,

Step 4



draw the yarn back through the work,

Step 5



you now have two loops on the hook,

Step 6



bring the yarn over the hook,

Step 7



draw the yarn through the two loops on the hook,

Step 8



1 double crochet completed.

Treble

Step 1



With one loop already on the hook bring the yarn over the hook,

Step 2



insert the hook as directed into the work and bring the yarn over the hook,

Step 3



draw the yarn through the work – you now have three loops on the hook,

Step 4



bring the yarn over the hook,

Step 5



draw the yarn through the first two loops on the hook,

Step 6



bring the yarn over the hook,

Step 7



draw the yarn through the last two loops on the hook.

Step 8



1 treble completed.
